

# 2 Thessalonians is our <u>reminder</u> to wait well for Christ's return.



#### Background of 2 Thessalonians

- Authors: Paul, Silas, & Timothy.
- **Date:** c. A.D. 52
- *Recipients:* The Church at Thessalonica, which Paul planted during his second missionary journey (c. A.D. 49-51; see *Acts 17:1-9*)
- **Purpose:** To correct false teaching about the return of Christ and to encourage faithful and diligent living until the return of Christ.

#### Structure of 2 Thessalonians

- 1:1-12 A *pastoral* word of *comfort*
- **2:1-17** A *prophetic* word of *caution*
- 3:1-18 A *practical* word of *command*

• The return of Christ is a major theme of the New Testament.

#### **Chapel Statement of Faith:**

We believe ... In the bodily Second Coming of the Lord Jesus Christ to claim His own people and to set all things in order.

1) When Christ comes, so will <u>relief</u> (1:5-7).

#### 1 Peter 4:12-13

Beloved, do not be surprised at the fiery trial when it comes upon you to test you, as though something strange were happening to you. But rejoice insofar as you share Christ's sufferings, that you may also rejoice and be glad when his glory is revealed.

1) When Christ comes, so will <u>relief</u> (1:5-7).

#### 1 Thessalonians 3:3-4

... that no one be moved by these afflictions. For you yourselves know that we are destined for this. For when we were with you, we kept telling you beforehand that we were to suffer affliction, just as it has come to pass, and just as you know.

2) When Christ comes, so will *vengeance* (1:8-9).

#### **Psalm 79:6**

Pour out your anger on the nations that do not know you, and on the kingdoms that do not call upon your name! (See also Jeremiah 10:25)

2) When Christ comes, so will *vengeance* (1:8-9).

2) When Christ comes, so will *vengeance* (1:8-9).

#### **Revelation 20:14-15**

Then Death and Hades were thrown into the lake of fire. This is the second death, the lake of fire. And if anyone's name was not found written in the book of life, he was thrown into the lake of fire.

#### John 3:36

Whoever believes in the Son has eternal life; whoever does not obey the Son shall not see life, but the wrath of God remains on him.

2) When Christ comes, so will <u>vengeance</u> (1:8-9).

3) When Christ comes, so will glory (1:10-12).

His glory in the future (1:10) ...

#### **Matthew 25:31**

"When the Son of Man comes in his glory, and all the angels with him, then he will sit on his glorious throne."

3) When Christ comes, so will glory (1:10-12).

His glory in the <u>future</u> (1:10) ...

3) When Christ comes, so will glory (1:10-12).

His glory in the <u>future</u> (1:10) ...

... and His glory in us in the present (1:12)!
