

"So that they might be with Him ..."

"And that He might send them out to preach and have authority to cast out demons."

#### Genesis 3:15:

I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your offspring and her offspring; he shall bruise your head, and you shall bruise his heel.

#### 1 John 3:8b

The reason the Son of God appeared was to destroy the works of the devil.

#### Hebrews 2:14

Since therefore the children share in flesh and blood, he himself likewise partook of the same things, that through death he might destroy the one who has the power of death, that is, the devil.
