The Big Idea – Part 1

Every Christian is a mixture of faith and faithlessness.



Matthew 12:43–45

“When the unclean spirit has gone out of a person, it passes through waterless places seeking rest, but finds none. 44 Then it says, ‘I will return to my house from which I came.’ And when it comes, it finds the house empty, swept, and put in order. 45 Then it goes and brings with it seven other spirits more evil than itself, and they enter and dwell there, and the last state of that person is worse than the first. So also will it be with this evil generation.”



The Big Idea

Every Christian is a mixture of faith and faithlessness. Admitting what we don't understand and asking questions we're afraid to ask is one way to grow our faith and reduce our doubt.



John 3:16

The phrase “whoever *believes in* Him should not perish but have eternal life” is literally “whoever *faiths in* Him should not perish but have eternal life.”
