

# December 3 • LUKE 1:5-12

Have you been chosen to do something no one else is allowed to do? How did Zechariah feel about doing his job? What does "righteous before God" mean?

#### December 4 • LUKE 1:13-17

How has God answered your prayers? Do you believe, that before you were born, God had a purpose for you?

## December 5 • LUKE 1:18-25

Why was it hard for Zechariah to believe the news the angel Gabriel told him? (v.18) Why did Zechariah doubt the Angel? Do you ever doubt God?

## December 6 • LUKE 1:26-33

God sent an angel to tell Mary about His special plan for her life. She was frightened and confused. Are you ever confused about God's ways?

# December 7 • LUKE 1:34-38

What does "NOTHING is impossible with God" mean? What seems impossible to you now but not for God? Discuss Mary's response to the angel in verse 38.

# December 8 • LUKE 1:39-45

Why do you think Mary visited Elizabeth? Why did Mary share her news with Elizabeth first? Who do you love to share good news with? Why?

#### December 9

Take today to catch up on any missed readings or spend time singing your favorite Christmas carols.

## December 10 • LUKE 1:46-50

Have you ever been so happy that you began to sing? What does Mary's song tell us? Write a song thanking God for something He has done for you.

## December 11 • LUKE 1:51-56

What does "mercy" mean and what does it tell you about God? Mary made a list of the good things God had done. Share your own list with someone.

# December 12 • LUKE 1:57-60

Ask a parent or grandparent if they know how your name was chosen for you. Why are names important? What does your name mean?

## December 13 • LUKE 1:61-66

What did Zechariah do once he could talk again? What would it be like if you couldn't talk? What are you rejoicing about this Advent?

## December 14 • LUKE 1:67-75

Discuss the special message God spoke through Zechariah. Listen to a praise song. What words mean the most to you? What can you praise God for?

#### December 15 • LUKE 1:76-80

God told Zechariah his son John would have a special job - what was the job? What does it mean to be "strong in spirit?" Are you strong in spirit?

## December 17 • **LUKE 2:1-7**

Where were you born? Where was Jesus born? Was it a nice place? What is important about Jesus being born there? (Read Micah 5:2)

## December 18 • LUKE 2:8-14

Who appeared to the shepherds? Why were they scared? Why did angels announce Jesus' birth? What is important about Jesus being born in a manger?

### December 19 • LUKE 2:15-21

What did the shepherds do after they saw the angels? What did they do after they saw Jesus? Why?

## December 20 • LUKE 2:22-24

Jesus' parents dedicated Him for God's service. What did this look like and how did they do it? How can we dedicate our lives to Jesus each day?

# December 21 • LUKE 2:25-32

Simeon trusted God. Why was it important to him that he see Jesus before he died? What are things that you can trust God for?

#### December 22 • LUKE 2:33-35

What did Jesus' parents think about Simeon's words? Do your parents like to hear good things about you? How do you react to the good news of Jesus?

#### December 24 • LUKE 2: 36-38

Why did Anna spend all of her time at the temple. What did she do there? How does knowing Jesus lead you to worship and tell others about Him?
