My Church: Built to Love the Eternal (2 Corinthians 4:13-18)

Please read 2 Corinthians 4:1-18

- 1. What situations in life have caused you to lose heart? Or feel deflated?
- 2. How does Paul suggest we respond to difficult situations that might otherwise cause us to lose heart? (verses 2, 10 & 15 offer insight)

Note to leader: Some of the actions Paul suggests are as follows:

- We set forth the truth plainly (verse 2)
- We expect difficulties since we reflect the life and death of Christ. (verse 10)
- We recognize that Christ is made more obvious to all when we continue to honor God in the midst of difficulties
- 3. Have you ever thought of your difficult situation as an opportunity for ministry? When?
- 4. Have you ever thought of your difficult situation as an opportunity to display the life you have in Christ? When?
- 5. Can you think of an example from another person's life where you saw new life (resurrection) in the midst of their difficulty?
- 6. What does "fixing our eyes on what is unseen" look like? (2 Cor 4:18)
- 7. Why does Paul encourage us to fix our eyes on Jesus?
