- 5. Which of these four words do you like best? Why?
- 6. With which of these four words do you have the easiest time? With which of these four words do you have the most difficult time?
- 7. Talk about a time someone has shown you the kind of love described in this verse. How did it impact your life?
- 8. Give an example of the things from which love protects others.
- 9. Is it ever okay to not "trust" someone? Why or why not?
- 10. Talk about a time when you have had a difficult time hoping the best for someone. How did you handle that struggle? How do you wish you had handled it?

Application: Think of one relationship in your life, and commit to find a way this week to show that person the kind of love discussed in 1 Corinthians 13:7.
