

## **Small Group Leaders' Guide | Sermon Questions, February 16, 2014**

My Church: Built to Love Truth (I Corinthians 15:1-19)

1. Travis asked the question, "How does this change the way we live out our faith?" Paul has suggested it changes the way we worship, enter disagreements, deal with weaker believers, take the Lord's Supper, act in marriage, and view death...How do you think it changes the way we live knowing this truth?
2. As we read verses 12-24...
  - a. What implication of "no resurrection" is most significant to you? Why?
  - b. What hope of the resurrection is most significant to you? Why?
  - c. In what ways does the resurrection bring purpose to this life? Give specific answers?
3. In verses 33 and 34 Paul issues a closing statement and calls believers to (1) avoid false teachers who reject the resurrection and (2) lead a holy life. Of all the applications to the teaching on the resurrection, what would drive Paul to choose these two applications?
4. What are situations in your life right now that could be thought of or handled differently because of the truth that "Jesus was raised and I will be too?"
