Words into Practice: *The Sermon on the Mount – Part 1* (Matthew 5:1-12)

Please read Matthew 5:3-10

1. Is there a time in your life when it was easier for you to be poor in spirit?

Note to Leader: Assume that “poor in spirit” means knowing that you are not able to “understand or do” anything without God.

2. Can you relate to mourning when you become aware of your need for God? How so?

3. Has God ever comforted you in your mourning? How did He do it?

4. Who is the meekest person you know? How do you typically see them interacting with others?

5. Which beatitude do you most wish God would perfect in you?

6. Is there a beatitude about which God is teaching you the most lately? Which one?
