- 1. What does Jesus instruct the disciples to do until he comes back?
- 2. Rich talked about the parable of the Ten Virgins in Matt 25:1-13. Rich challenged us to be ready for the "long haul." What are some ways that we can be prepared for the long haul?
- 3. What things come to mind when thinking of the return of Jesus?
- 4. Compare Matthew 24:36 to Acts 1:7. How are they similar? How are they different?
- 5. Rich taught about the parable of the talents (Matt 25:14-30) and challenged us to take risks for the kingdom. What does it look like to take a risk for the kingdom?
- 6. Is God calling you to take risks (or actions) for the kingdom? Can you share what they might be?
