- 6. What usually gets you mad or indignant? Is anger ever good? When?
- 7. Do you have any anger that you need to turn away from? Do you need to make amends or seek forgiveness for any recent angry outbursts?
- 8. Do you get excited about that day when Jesus will establish the Kingdom of God completely? What most excites you?
