Summer Bible Study: Judges (Judges 2:6-19)

Please read Judges 2:6-19

1. How are you passing your faith on to the next generation? As a parent, or as a member of our Chapel family, how are you intentionally creating way to share your faith with the children at the Chapel?
2. How can we read Romans 12:1-2 and 1 Peter 2:9-12 in light of Judges 2? What does living in the world but not of the world look like? What are the greatest challenges?
3. Why was it so important to eliminate the Canaanites? What does that look like today in our own lives? What were the obstacles that are described in chapter 1? What our obstacle today?
4. What can we learn about God's character as we read Judges 2?
5. How can you explain the work of God to both fight against the Israelites and also rescue them? What does this communicate to us about God?
6. What does this passage say about the nature of man, the nature of God and the story of our redemption?
7. What does God's anger tell us about his faithfulness? How do anger and love go together?
8. What is the draw to the Canaanite way of life?
9. What separates "Canaanite living" from following Jesus?
