Summer Bible Study: Ehud (Judges 3:12-30)

Read Judges 3:12-30

1. Why do you think we tend to fall into old bad habits?
2. Have you ever broken an old habit? How did you do it?
3. Were there times that you didn't care about being enslaved by your bad habit?

What finally made you care?

4. The passage said that the Israelites did evil which implies that they didn't obey God's will for their life. How do you know when you are obeying God's will and when you are not?

Please read Colossians 3:5-11

5. Of all the things you see listed as part of the sinful nature, which ones involve relationships?
6. Which of the sins listed is hardest for you to put to death? Or said differently, which one are you most likely to practice?

Please read Colossians 3:1-4

7. Paul does not just tell us to not do certain things (Col 3:5-11), he also tells us to do certain things (Col 3:1-4). What can you do to help set your hearts & minds on things above?
