The following questions are taken from the book entitled Be Rich by Warren Wiersbe. Please do not feel compelled to ask every question that is listed below. You know your group better than the person writing the questions. Ask the questions that are best for your group, and questions that you yourself are comfortable answering.

1. What do you do when things become old?
2. Read Ephesians 4:17-32. How did Paul compare the old, or unsaved, man with the new, or saved?
3. How does this description compare with his previous descriptions of unsaved and saved people | Ephesians 2:1-9?
4. Why should believers live differently than they did before they were saved?
5. Look at the sins that Paul specifically names in verses 25-32 that we are to get rid of. How does each of these sins undermine the body of Christ?
6. Which of these sins is the greatest temptation for you? How so?
7. How do we grieve the Holy Spirit?
8. What should be our motives for putting "on the new man"?
9. What old sins have you discarded since you became a Christian?
10. How can you "put off" the old man and "put on" the new man?
