The Movement of God's People | 40 Years with Rueben and Gad (Num. 32:1-23)

1. Doug talked a lot about determining when and how God is moving, often times, its far more plain and obvious than we like to think. Like the Israelites in the story, have you ever experienced a plain provision or leading of God that surprised you by being so obvious?
2. What is the challenge of the tension between looking around empirically (observation) for God's leading and waiting for more of a direct call/voice/word from the Lord to lead you? How can a faith community (like a small group) play a role in that process?
3. Look around your group, what role do you all need to play in the next generation for teaching and admonishing about the faithfulness and providence of God? How can your group begin to make an intentional investment in the generation below you – sharing what God had shown/taught you with them?
