## Small Group Questions | October 15th, 2017

Kingdom Values: Kingdom Relationships (Matthew 5:38-48)

**Sermon Recap:** Travis spoke on Kingdom Relationships and Jesus' exhoration to: *reject retaliation, rethink rights, give generously,* and *do what love requires* in our relationships. He echoed Jesus' refrain, "You have heard it said" **Be Right**, "but I say" **Be Reconciled**. For *his* Kingdom is manefest in our world when *his* people live loving relationships.

**Hook:** These questions can help encourage conversation.

- 1. What advice have you heard about conflict?
- 2. What are some of your most important relationships in your life?

**Look**: Read the sermon passage. Answer the following textual questions.

- 3. What advice does scripture give us for relationships? Also read Proverbs 26:20, Exodus 14:14, and Romans 2:1-5. What advice do these passages yield?
- 4. How have we distorted Jesus' commands on loving our enemies?
- 5. Also read Romans 15:3. How did Jesus exhibit the behaviors he talked about in the SOM?

**Took**: Applying the message to our lives.

- 6. What does it look like for you to move from a 'be right' mentality to a 'be reconciled' mentality (seeing enemies as brothers and sisters)?
- 7. What are some practical ways to take logs off the fire and/or create space for God to work?
- 8. Have you ever had do what love requires even when it was painful?

**Prayer/Verse**: Spend a few minutes praying specifically for reconciliation and stuck relationships for group members.
