- 3. According to v. 19, what is the kingdom mission?
- 4. Read Mt 14:29-30. Why is it possible for worship and doubt to exist in this situation (v. 17)?
- 5. According to the passage, who is supposed to baptize and teach? By what authority? With what power?

Took: Applying the message to our lives.

- 6. Does your personal belief/doubt change the mission that Jesus gave us?
- 7. Have you asked God to show you your kingdom mission? If not, will you? What is it?
- 8. Are you alone in your mission? Where do you find help?
- 9. How do you disciple someone? Is there someone God wants you to begin praying for and reaching out to?
