## Small Group Questions | June 10<sup>th</sup> 2018

Kingdom Mission - Kingdom Mission - Partnership (Matthew 4:18-25)

**Sermon Recap:** Today's passage, reminds us that partnership propels the mission because partnership reflects God's nature, partnership refines us and partnership restores creation. Partnership requires us to leave and follow Jesus.

## **Hook:** These questions can help encourage conversation.

1. When was the last time you felt like you were hanging on by your fingernails?

**Look**: Read the sermon passage. Answer the following textual questions.

- 2. How does partnership reflect God's nature? (vv.17-19 and Gen 1:1-3)
- 3. Make a list of all the things the brothers had to let go of in order to follow Jesus. (vv.17-19)
- 4. Read Ecc. 4:9-12. What do you learn about the importance of partnership? According to v. 12, what is the key to partnership? (See also vv. 20-22)
- 5. In Matt 4:23, what were the three things Jesus was doing? Describe how those three things restore us as God's image bearers.

**Took**: Applying the message to our lives.

- 6. What are you holding on to alone? And, how long have you been holding on to it?
- 7. Has your small group been holding onto anything that you might need to let go of?
- 8. Like the brothers in the passage, what do you need to evaluate in order to let go? How can partnership help you?
- 9. As a group, define partnership in practical terms. To do this, review the Sermon recap.
- 10. We are inviting people into partnership to give away what we have (our relationship with Christ). What is the biggest roadblock individually or as a small group to living on mission?

**Prayer/Verse:** "For we are his workmanship, created in Jesus Christ for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them." Eph. 2: 10
