# The Psalms are a sign pointing us to biblical worship.

#### Observations about Psalms of Confidence:

1) They often follow psalms of lament (Psalms of Lament) and *Psalms of Confidence*: (6) 7, (10) 11, 12, (22) 23, (26) 27, (60) 61, 62, (69) 70, 71, (90) 91, (120) 121

2) They often employ striking metaphors

### God as Security:

O Lord my God, in you do I take refuge; save me from all my pursuers and deliver me, lest like a lion they tear my soul apart, rending it in pieces, with none to deliver.

- Psalm 7:1-2

## God as Security:

Even though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil, for you are with me; your rod and your staff, they comfort me.

- Psalm 23:4

## God as Security:

For God alone, O my soul, wait in silence, for my hope is from him. He only is my rock and my salvation, my fortress; I shall not be shaken. On God rests my salvation and my glory; my mighty rock, my refuge is God.

- Psalm 62:5-7

#### God as a Warrior:

Arise, O Lord! Save me, O my God! For you strike all my enemies on the cheek; you break the teeth of the wicked.

#### God as a Warrior:

If a man does not repent, God will whet his sword; he has bent and readied his bow; he has prepared for him his deadly weapons, making his arrows fiery shafts.

## Relying on God's protection:

Therefore my heart is glad, and my whole being rejoices; my flesh also dwells secure. For you will not abandon my soul to Sheol, or let your holy one see corruption.

- Psalm 16:9-10

## Relying on God's protection:

For God alone my soul waits in silence; from him comes my salvation. He alone is my rock and my salvation, my fortress; I shall not be greatly shaken.
